



COLLEGE TRANSPORT

The College is committed to enabling all students who wish to study at Barton Peveril to **travel here easily**. The College consequently provides our students with an extensive and cost effective network of **subsidised** bus transport.

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES OR ADDITIONAL NEEDS

Students with disabilities or special needs will continue to be the responsibility of Hampshire County Council, provided Barton Peveril is your nearest Sixth Form College. Any contribution towards transport will be in accordance with Hampshire County Council policy. TRANSPORT ARRANGEMENTS

The College has agreed with bus companies the following arrangements: -

- Students will be allocated a bus, in accordance with their request. This bus **MUST** be used by students when their journey to or from College starts as per bus timetable.
- The ticket is valid for travel until 18.30 hours on College days.
- Bluestar bus passes can be used on First Bus routes 26,72,80 and 94 on College days

WHEN DO I APPLY FOR A BUS PASS?

Application for College transport should be made as soon as you have accepted a place at Barton Peveril. Applications can be made:

- On-line via College website www.barton-peveril.co.uk
- Application form, provided at interview, (by post or in person)
- By phone to Transport Officer on 023 8036 7214

The routes of the buses are flexible and planned according to students preferred pick up point, to assist our planning early application is requested. Application forms must be completed by the student and returned to the College **by the closing date of 10th July 2012**.

HOW MUCH WILL I HAVE TO PAY?

For 2012-2013 the College has introduced price zoning, where pick up points within 3 miles of College (zone 1) will cost £480 per annum, all others (zone 2) will cost £560 per annum.

All applicants must pay an £80.00 deposit (£50 refundable in the event your son/daughter chooses not to attend Barton Peveril Sixth Form College). Details for payment of the deposit can be found on the application form.

Applications where no deposit is received will not be processed.

Payment of the balance will be required to be made in full by 20th August 2012, to ease family budgets payments may be made in instalments. Details of how to make these payments will be sent to you once we have received the application and deposit.

For Brijan Route 607 termly costs will be advised by Brijan in summer 2012.

Financial Assistance

Applicants who are seeking financial assistance from the College Student Support Fund should note that the maximum level of assistance will be £300 leaving a parental contribution to be made, this balance will also require to be made by 20th August 2012.

REFUNDS

Deposit in full should your son/daughter choose not to attend Barton Peveril and you notify the College before 10th July 2012.

Deposit £50 refund should your son/daughter choose not to attend Barton Peveril and you notify the College after 10th July 2012.

Balance in full should your son/daughter choose not to attend Barton Peveril and you notify the College before the start of term September 2012.

Once College has commenced refunds are only authorised **where students leave College** and will be made against the production of the bus pass. If the bus pass is not produced, the refund will be made on the expiry date of the ticket. There are no refunds in the summer term.

HOW LONG WILL MY BUS PASS LAST?

Transport is granted for one academic year at a time. Students starting a second or subsequent year of a course must submit a further application form for travel in that year.

HOW DO I COLLECT MY BUS PASS?

You will be able to collect your bus pass when you attend Enrolment Day. **No bus passes can be issued without payment and you will need to make your own way to College until payment is made.**
