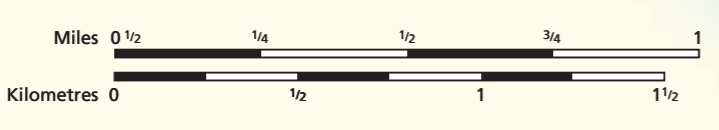
ROAD SIGNS FOR CYCLISTS

- cycle route for use by cyclists and pedestrians together
- cycle route for use by cyclists and pedestrians on separate sides of path
- cycle route for use by cyclists only
- route reserved for use by cyclists only (road marking)
- cycle route ahead
- cyclists should walk at this point
- recommended route for cyclists to use (usually on road with no provisions for cyclists)
- direction signs showing recommended route for cyclists
- cycle lane on the road ahead
- cycle lane on the road for use by cyclists in the same direction as the other traffic
- cycle lane on the road for use by cyclists in the opposite direction to the other traffic (usually on one-way roads)
- advisory contraflow sign
- warning sign for pedestrians that there is a cycle lane ahead or that there is a cycleway crossing the road ahead
- no cycling

- On road advisory cycle route or convenient link road
- Rural Bridleway (cyclists are permitted to use bridleways but should give way to pedestrians and horse riders. Bridleways may not be in a suitable condition for cycling in all weathers)
- Permissive cycle routes in daylight hours
- Proposed cycle routes for completion in the next 5 years
- Footpath or track
- Rail line and Station
- Ferry
- Borough Boundary
- Toucan crossing
- Cycle shop
- Proposed toucan crossing for completion in the next 5 years
- Cycle Parking
- Tourist attraction
- Advanced stop line
