## Other useful information

### Request to change course

There will be a period of no change. This is so that students can really try and get to grips with their chosen courses and talk to their teachers about how they might learn to study the course. The period of no change will be from Monday 10th September to Friday 14th September 2019.

The period of change commences Monday 17th September and finishes 4pm Friday 19th October. There will be no changes after this period. This is because we believe it is in the students' best interest that they are committed to their courses after the October Half term which leaves them with a total of 66 teaching weeks to complete a full A Level.

In order to change a subject, students must make an online SPA appointment. We will not be able to accommodate any drop ins because of the volume and complexity of the work. Any changes are subject to availability and to timetabling.

It is important to remember that the college Admissions Policy states that it is Barton Peveril's expectation that students complete three A levels or equivalent qualifications.
